Year 7 Spanish (2 hours per week)

Textbook: Mira 1 (Express)

Autumn Term 1 : ¡Vamos! (module 1)

- Introducing yourself and basic greetings
- Counting up to 31
- Saying when your birthday is
- Learning about Spanish-speaking countries
- Learning the Spanish alphabet
- Talking about the classroom

Autumn Term 2: Mi familia (module 3)

- Talking about your family
- Talking about your pets
- Talking about your appearance and character, as well those of other people
- Talking about eyes and hair
- Where you live / nationality (also Mira 1, module 4.1: describing where you live)
- How Christmas is celebrated in Spanish speaking countries

Spring Term: En el instituto (module 2)

- Talking about your school subjects
- Saying what you do in lessons
- Talking about your teachers
- Giving opinions and reasons
- Daily routine
- School uniform (Mira 2, module 5)
- How Easter is celebrated in Spanish speaking countries

Summer Term: En tiempo libre (module 5)

- Saying what you do in your free time
- Telling the time
- Talking about sports
- Saying what you like to do
- Saying what you are going to do

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Students will be given vocab tests and grammar tests at regular intervals. Tests on the skills of listening and reading will be conducted through-out each topic on an informal basis. The active skills of speaking and writing will be tested as part of ongoing formative tests. There will be an exam in the summer.

Students will be given vocab tests and grammar tests at regular intervals. Tests on the skills of listening and reading will be conducted through-out each topic on an informal basis. The active skills of speaking and writing will be tested as part of ongoing formative tests. There will be an exam in the summer.



Year 9 Spanish (2 hours per week) - Textbook: ¡Viva! Edexcel GCSE Spanish 9-1

GCSE Spanish course to follow the Edexcel syllabus. It is a full course.

Content and assessment overview:

- The **Pearson Edexcel** Level 1/Level 2 GCSE (9-1) in Spanish consists of four externally examined papers based on the following skills: *listening, speaking, reading and writing*. (25% each)
- Students must complete their speaking assessment in April/May and all other assessments in May/June in any single year. (Year 11)
- Each paper is available at Foundation tier or Higher tier.
