Outcome: Recount - Letter Writing. Using the first person, writing in paragraphs, using apostrophes for contraction, using tenses correctly
Spelling: Prefix 'un-'. Practise prefix 'dis-'. Learn words with the /eɪ/ sound spelt 'ei' (vein), 'eigh' (eight), 'aigh' (straight) or 'ey' (they)
 Homophones.
Handwriting Revise letter formation and initial joins. Use the Nelson scheme to write out the spellings.

Mathematics
Number and place value - Numbers up to and beyond 1 000, negative numbers. Read Roman Numerals from 1 to 12 (clock face). Read Roman numerals to 100 (I to C) and understand how numbers developed to include 0.
Calculation and arithmetic of addition and subtraction - Add and subtract numbers mentally. Estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operations to check answers. Add and subtract numbers using columnar methods. Estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operations to check answers. Solve addition and subtraction problems.
