FOREST SCHOOL

We have started taking the children to Forest School on a **Wednesday morning**.

Forest School is where the children experience the outdoors in a woodland setting and explore what is around them. It is a great place to see the changing seasons and is lovely at this time of year with the leaves changing colour and falling from the trees.

The children have opportunities to climb trees, make mud pies, look for insects, make dens and explore our fairy garden.

What does my child need to bring for Forest School?

As we go out to Forest School in the morning we ask that they come dressed ready to go outside. They will need:

A warm/waterproof coat

Wellies

Hat, scarf & gloves (as the weather gets colder)

Trousers

Long sleeve top

Waterproofs – not essential but very useful if you have them.

Can you also please send in a change of clothes with your child as the children can get wet and muddy out in the forest. When sending a change of clothes please can you include socks and pants too!!
