| Subject   | How will mocks be carried out?   | Specific date/time  |

| English   | All four English exams need to be completed. The language papers one and week and the lit the other week. | Maths     | This term we will be assessing students' progress grade by using student Oct/Nov mock result as a baseline and then judging whether to lift this grade up based on work completed on Mathswatch. Maths will send all three Maths papers home with the advice that students can complete the papers however they like but with an honest comment (e.g. if you did it in exam conditions or not) | N/A – notes on how to complete the mocks will accompany the papers  |
| Science   | Full set of mocks to be sent home. Completed in own time – honest comment on how you completed the papers.   | Chemistry & Physics paper 1 – back in school by 29 January<br><br>Chemistry & Physics paper 2 back by 5 February  |
| Geography | Paper to be completed at home  | Component 1 exam – to be completed on the 25 <sup>th</sup> January<br><br>Theme 5 and 6 exam - to be completed on the 1 <sup>st</sup> February.   |
| PE        | 4 papers to be sent home and completed in lesson time  | Paper 2a- Monday 25 <sup>th</sup> Jan<br><br>Paper 1a- Tuesday 26 <sup>th</sup> Jan<br>Paper 1a continued- Thursday 28 <sup>th</sup> Jan<br><br>Paper 2b- Monday 1 <sup>st</sup> Feb<br><br>Paper 1b- Tuesday 2 <sup>nd</sup> Feb<br>Paper 1b continued- Thursday 4 <sup>th</sup> Feb |
