Science	Both Biology mocks sent home. Completed in own time – honest comment on how you completed the papers.	Biology 1 – back in school by 29 January Biology paper 2 back by 5 February
<p>MFL – schedule Mon 18th period 2 exam revision – taught lesson.</p> <p>Tues 19th period 5 (tutorial session) or time of students choosing on that day. Reading Paper</p> <p>Wed 20th period 2 (tutorial session) (10.25) Listening paper Students must accept the call and then listen to the audio files through the screen. A copy of the audio files will be uploaded shortly after in case of technical problems and students can listen through headphones at home</p> <p>Fri 22 period 2 (taught lesson) Writing paper. After a short introduction about the paper and checking of comprehension students can complete the paper in real time or later that day.</p> <p>Students can choose to use reference material such as 100 word sheet and vocab booklet only and must record what they have used on the front of the paper.</p>	<p>To be completed at home during lesson time and following this schedule</p> <p>Please sign the front of each paper stating how the test was completed. Eg I completed this test in exam conditions or</p> <p>I completed this test over a period of time using my vocab book and exercise books to help.</p> <p>Students may ask parents to sign to authenticate also</p>	Deadline 29 January returned to school
