Thank you for supporting your son/daughter in completing their mock exam papers in this highly unusual, stressful situation. We appreciate the hard working, effort and diligence the majority of pupils put into completing their papers.

Subjects will be feeding back individually to pupils with their marks. It is important to note that as these papers were completed outside of the formal school conditions, we will not be able to use them as sole evidence when making our centre assessed grades.

The government are still devising criteria for how school will be allowed to make judgement but we expect that it will involve using a range of evidence and that any appeal to grades will be through a formal process overseen by Ms Lovecy. She will be working closely with staff to ensure that assessments reach the high standards that the DfE demand.

In a few weeks you will receive a report from school detailing current and expected grades which take into account the mock papers, assessments completed and teacher judgement. These will be the best indicator to your son/daughter's progress across subjects and will be a starting point for the formal assessment process. Please continue to support your child, encouraging them to produce work that is representative of their abilities and which can provide evidence for teachers of their working level.
