**Writing Text:** Seal Surfer by  
**Reading Text:** The Sea Book by Charlotte Milner  
**Outcome: Recount - Letter Writing.** Using the first person, writing in paragraphs, using apostrophes for contraction, using tenses correctly  
**Spelling:** Prefix 'un-'. Practise prefix 'dis-'. Learn words with the /eɪ/ sound spelt 'ei' (vein), 'eigh' (eight), 'aigh' (straight) or 'ey' (they)  
 Homophones.  
**Handwriting** Revise letter formation and initial joins. Use the Nelson scheme to write out the spellings.

**Mathematics**  
**Number and place value** - Numbers up to and beyond 1 000, negative numbers. Read Roman Numerals from 1 to 12 (clock face). Read Roman numerals to 100 (I to C) and understand how numbers developed to include 0.  
**Calculation and arithmetic of addition and subtraction** - Add and subtract numbers mentally. Estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operations to check answers. Add and subtract numbers using columnar methods. Estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operations to check answers. Solve addition and subtraction problems.
