



CURRICULUM MAP RECEPTION AUTUMN 2022

Personal, Social, emotional development **SM**

Our children will be learning to:

Form good friendships with others and be kind to one another.

Think about the feelings of others and know what to do if someone is feeling sad or upset or if they are feeling sad/upset.

Be able to keep trying if things are hard.

Put their clothes and shoes on by themselves.

Know what healthy food are and why it is important to brush their teeth regularly.

See themselves as a valuable individual

Physical development

The following skills will be developed and built upon during our weekly P.E sessions.

-rolling -crawling -walking -jumping -running -hopping -skipping -climbing

These sessions will develop overall body-strength, balance, co-ordination and agility.

We will continue to develop their fine motor skills so that they can use pencils effectively for drawing and writing as well as using other things such as paintbrushes, scissors, knives, forks and spoons.

Communication and language **S**

Our children will be learning to:

Understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important.

Learn new vocabulary.

Listen carefully to rhymes and songs, paying attention to how they sound.

Use new vocabulary through the day.

Ask questions to find out more and to check they understand what has been said to them.

Join in with story times.

Listen to and talk about stories to show they understand what they have heard.

Mathematics

Our Reception children will be learning to:

Count objects, actions and sounds.

Subitise – recognise a small amount of objects in a group without having to count.

We will be asking the children to talk about what they notice.

Count beyond ten and compare numbers.

Understand 'one more than/one less than'

Explore how numbers up to 5 are made. For example 5 is the same as 3 plus 2 or 1+1+1+1+1

Recognise that a shape can have other shapes within it, just as numbers can.

Continue, copy and create repeating patterns.

Compare length, weight and capacity.



Literacy

Children will start to learn Phase 2 letter sounds through our phonics scheme Supersonic Phonic Friends.

They will learn four letter sounds weekly.

They will learn to hear the sounds with Listening Len and then blend the sounds together with Blending Ben

We will be showing the children how to write words and simple sentences and reading back to check that it makes sense.

They will be learning to write some letters accurately and will be encouraged to write their name daily.

This term we will be focusing on the book The Gingerbread Man.

Expressive Art and Design

This term our theme in Music is ME and the children will be learning to sing and perform several nursery rhymes along with some new songs.

Using the story of the Gingerbread Man the children will be creating their own gingerbread man/cake.

We will be creating pieces of art related to Bonfire Night, Diwali and Christmas.

Understanding the World **SC**

The children will be learning to:

Name and describe people who are familiar to them.

We will look at different celebrations and festivals that occur in this term such as Diwali, Bonfire Night and Christmas.

Through being outside and during our Forest School sessions the children will have opportunities to explore the natural world around them.
