	<ul> <li>Our children will have opportunities to:</li> <li>Develop their fine motor skills by engaging in specific activities that help to strengthen their hands and then use this to develop an effective panel grip.</li> </ul>	We are encouraging the children to talk about their feelings and helping them to understand what they can do if they find their feelings are making them sad, angry or upset. We are going to introduce the <i>Zones of Regulation</i> in line with the rest of the Primary Phase.
Literacy - Our children will have opportunities to: Continue to take part in our Phase One phonic sessions which encourage them to listen to sounds made by instruments, the environment and their voices as well as activities that develop their ability to hear rhythm and rhyme. Listen to stories daily – this may be in small groups or in larger groups. We talk about the different features of stories and books. We will be focusing on the following Nursery rhymes: 1,2,3,4,5 Once I caught a fish alive, The Big Ship sails on the Ally Ally Oh,	Aspiration Contraction Contra	<ul> <li>Mathematics Our children will have opportunities to:</li> <li>Subitise – be able to see a small amount of objects without needing to count.</li> <li>Count a variety of objects.</li> <li>Explore and be able to name common 2D shapes.</li> <li>What do you notice? What do you see?</li> <li>We will be using Master the Curriculum Nursery Maths from this term.</li> </ul>
