English Main Text - Leon and the Space Between by by Grahame Baker Smith & Angela McAllister. The Big-Top Mysteries: The Case of the Vanishing Granny by Alexander McCall Smith. Class Novel - The Nowhere Emporium by Ross Mackenzie. Writing - Recounts, invitations, fliers, first person character perspectives, character descriptions. SPAG - Standard English, conjunctions, main and subordinate clauses, apostrophes for possession, plural and possessive 'S'. Handwriting - the Nelson scheme (og, re, oo, sl, ck, st, nk).

Mathematics Add and subtract numbers with up to 4 digits using the formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction where appropriate. Solve number and practical problems that involve all of the above and with increasingly large positive numbers. Estimate and use inverse operations to check answers to a calculation. Convert between different units of measure [for example, kilometre to metre; hour to minute]. Measure and calculate the perimeter of a rectilinear figure (including squares) in centimetres and metres. Recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12×12 (ongoing throughout the term). Use place value, known and derived facts to multiply and divide mentally, including: multiplying by 0 and 1; dividing by 1; multiplying together three numbers. Review the Autumn curriculum and re visit the areas that assessment has shown there to be gaps in learning.
