## LOGGING IN TO MATHSWATCH;

- Browse to VLE.Mathswatch.co.uk
- If you Google Mathswatch make sure it is a .co.uk site, and then look for 'VLE login' on the front page to get the login box.
- Your login is firstnamelastname@stmartins3-16 but obvs replace firstnamelastname with your actual name.
- If you have a hyphen in your name, then it's in your login too.
- Your password is algebra (all lower case)
- If a yellow 'Sorry...' box appears check you have used the correct login and password.
  Common mistakes are upper case in the password or people using school email for your login, this won't work.
- If details are correct and the 'Sorry...' box still appears, spam the button Mathswatch is sometimes slow to let people in.
- If you still can't get in TELL YOUR TEACHER.
