SPORTS DAYS 2026

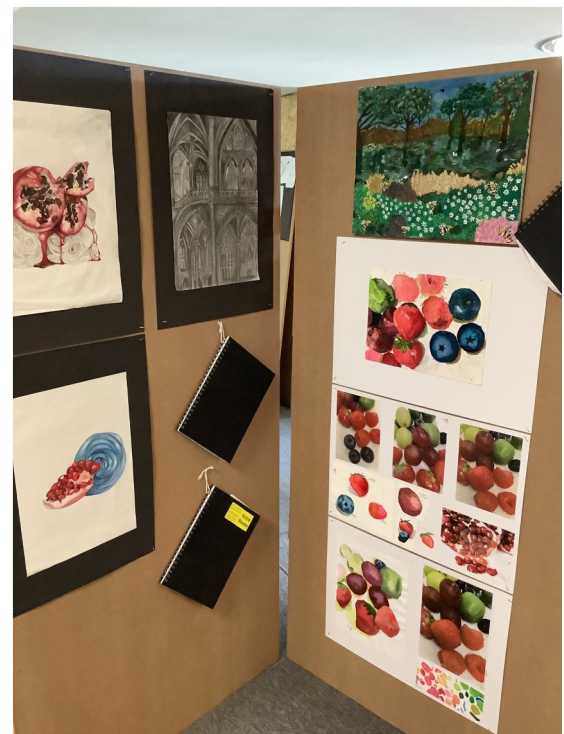
We have had to make a change to the SECONDARY SPORTS days because of the dates we've been given for the Cadet camps.
