Grey/Black school tailored trousers.

They must not have logos. They must not be canvas or jean style. **Leggings are not permitted in school.**

Grey for years 4-8 and black for year 9-11



Boys' black tailored trousers, not tracksuit style , not jeans, canvas or cotton jean style

Grey for years 4-8 and black for year 9-11



Black socks or plain opaque black tights.

Knee length socks can be worn by primary students but are not acceptable for secondary

Dark plain outdoor coat without logo's - no hoodies, denim leather or faux leather jackets are permitted in school





Tailored knee length shorts can be worn for the summer term.

These must be knee length and not cargo, jean, sports or tracksuit style. They must not have visible pockets. They must be grey for years up to and including year 8, black for years 9-11. They must be worn with black school shoes.

Nail Extensions and Acrylic Nails

We would like to remind parents and carers that students are not permitted to wear acrylic, gel, or false nails, or have excessively long nails in school.

This is in line with our uniform and safety expectations. Long or artificial nails can pose a health and safety risk in practical lessons such as PE, science and technology, and can also make it difficult for students to participate fully in learning.

We appreciate your support in ensuring students attend school with natural, short nails suitable for the school environment.
